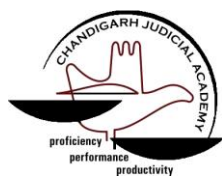




Chandigarh Judicial Academy

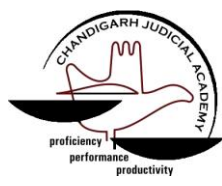
Hon'ble Mr. Justice P. Sathasivam, Judge, Supreme Court of India had kindly consented to be the Chief Guest for the function.

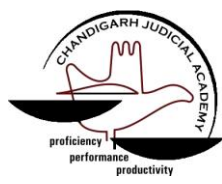
