2012 (copy enclosed)."



No. 165 Rules/II.D4.—1. Rule 6(f) of Chapter 16 Part A of Rules and Orders of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Volume-4 is amended as under :—

"6(f) **Abstracts of the case evidence and judgment.**—The abstract of the case, depositions of witnesses and judgments must in every instance be written on paper of superior quality having **70 gsm and of legal size**. The judgement should be typed on one side of the paper only. All the judgements should be typed on computer with font 'Thorndale' and size of the font '14' in double space with margins 1.26" on top and bottom of the page and 1.65" on left and 1.05" on the right side.

2. Rule 18-A below Rule 18 of Punjab Civil and Criminal Courts Preparation and Supply of Copies of Records Rules, 1965 contained in Chapter 17 of Rules and Orders of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Volume-4, is inserted as under :—

“18(A) Standards to be followed regarding preparation of certified copies :—

- (a) All the judgements should be typed on computer with font 'Thorndale' and size of font '14'
- (b) The judgements should be typed in double space with margin of 1.26" on top and bottom of the page with 1.65" on left and 1.05" on right side
- (c) The paper used should be of superior quality having 70 gsm and of legal size
- (d) The judgement should be typed on one side of the paper only.”

No. 238 Rules/XI.Y. 16.—In accordance with the provisions of Section 23 of the General Clauses Act (X of 1897), the following draft amendment in the Code of Civil Procedure which the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh proposes to make under Section 122 of that Code, is published for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby. Any objection to the said amendment should be addressed in writing to the Registrar, High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh, so as to reach him within fifteen days after the publication of this notification in the Government Gazettes of Punjab, Haryana and Chandigarh Administration whereafter the draft amendments will be finally considered :—

Sr. No. 1(vi) of sub-rule (9) of Order 18 Rule 4 of Code of Civil Procedure is amended as under :—

- “1(vi) Legal practitioners with 5 years of standing at the Bar (having adequate experience of examining the witnesses) having been so empanelled by the High Court”
