

HIGH COURT OF PUNJAB AND HARYANA AT CHANDIGARH

NOTIFICATION

No. 153 Gaz. II/XXI.C.35

Dated 11.9.13

In partial modification of this Court's Notification No. 273/Gaz. II/XXI.C.35 dated 30.08.1996, Hon'ble the Chief Justice and Judges of the High Court of Punjab and Haryana, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 26 of the Punjab Courts Act, 1918, have been pleased to redefine the pecuniary jurisdiction of Civil Judges in the States of Punjab, Haryana and U.T., Chandigarh henceforth as follows:

- (a) Civil Judge (Junior Division): to deal with the cases having jurisdictional value upto ₹ 10 lacs, but would not be entitled for any benefit attached to the post of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division);
- (b) Civil Judge (Senior Division) and Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division): shall exercise the jurisdiction in respect of all cases.

Provided that the Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), at the time of entrustment of suits for declaration where a dispute as regards genuineness of Will has been raised, shall broadly examine the matter and in case he is of the opinion that there is complexity in the matter then the same shall either be tried by himself or be entrusted to the officer of the rank of Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.).

In partial modification of this Court's Notification No. 326-Gaz. II/XXI.C.35, dated 28.11.1995, Hon'ble the Chief Justice and Judges of the High Court of Punjab and Haryana, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 26 of the Punjab Courts Act, 1918, have been pleased to empower all Civil Judges (Junior Division) in the States of Punjab and Haryana, having atleast 3 years service to deal with cases having jurisdictional value above Rs.2 lacs but they will not be entitled for any benefit attached to the post of Addl. NOTIFICATION

-Gaz. II/XXI.C.35, Dated, Chandigarh, the 28.11.95

In pursuance of the amendment in section 18 of the Punjab Courts Act (both by the States of Punjab and Haryana and in supersession of Punjab High Court Notification No. 279-Gaz./XXI.C.35, dated the 12th September, 1963, the Hon'ble the Chief Justice and Judges of the High Court of Punjab and Haryana, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 of the Punjab Courts Act, 1910, pleased to determine the pecuniary jurisdiction with effect from the date of issue of notification (or date to be specified) of Civil Judges to be exercised by them in original

Civil Suits, namely :-

- I. Civil Judges (Senior Division) exercising jurisdiction in the cases above the value of Rs. 2 lacs.
- II. Civil Judges (Junior Division) exercising jurisdiction in the cases upto the value

When a Civil Judge is appointed to any of the class constituted by the notification he shall exercise jurisdiction therein before defined for the class to which he is appointed within the local limits of the district to which he may be posted from time to time.
